Competitions in 2018

1st FAI European Indoor Skydiving Championships, Norway, April 11-14

Apart from a few technical issues pre-competition, the competition ran smoothly. We were struggling to get enough judges, but due to the judging course before the competition we were fortunate to get a full panel. These are the numbers:

Solo Freestyle: 10 teams

Solo Freestyle Junior: 7 teams

Dynamic 4-way: 3 teams (No Championship title due to only 3 NAC's)

Dynamic 2-way: 11 teams

Before the competition the Event Judge recognized there was a mistake in the rules describing the Brackets. The Event Judge was given the permission by the Judges Committee and CJ to go ahead with the competition with slightly altered Brackets. The Working Group was asked by the Bureau to present updated CR within one month. This work is reflected in the new rules being effective June 19th, here is a summary of the changes:

Judging Course for Dynamic was cancelled due to lack of participants. Dynamic 4-way was cancelled due to few teams registering. We had difficulty getting enough judges to fill the panel also for this competition.

Dynamic 2-way: 19 teams
Freestyle Junior: 13 participants

Competitor meetings were held after all the competitions. The working group has been recording all the feedback. The Working Group has used mostly Facebook for communicating.

Judging

Before the European Championships in Voss two more Dynamic Judges qualified. We are in desperate need of more judges in Dynamic. For 2019 we intend to organize more judging courses and encourage former competitors to attend. We also have a challenge to make sure the panel of judges have the required training before every competition. There is currently work being done to create an online test for judges to refresh their skills before a competition. It is our wish to find a way to implement this into the IPC in the future.

Rule changes Dynamic

#	THEME	Questions under discussion
1	D4W	D4W: allow only speed rounds except for World Championships
2	Challenges	prepare a form for challenges, as an appendix
3	Patterns	Rephrase mix snake and mix shuffler: replace "when passing the center" by "when passing the sideline"
4	Judges	Assistant for the Event Judge helping with writing live busts, results etc. down
5		How to make sure judges are current before every competition
6	Challenges	Visibility of challenges
7		prepare a form for challenges, as an appendix
8	Penalties	Synchronization bust: a need to keep it?
9		Connector bust: a need to keep it?
10	Competitors	Time that should be offered by organizer of EISC/WCIS for the training during last 2-4 days before the comp. Each team should have a chance to train in the organizing tunnel.
11	Scoring	review by the judges frame by frame vs. time allotted by organizers
12		free routine described on the paper sheet - this should be mandatory
13		Free round in the battles during the tournament: scoring each routine by exact numbers vs. vote for the winner.
14		Free routine should be delivered to the chief judge 3 days in advance (72 hours) - static view and uploaded on google drive with access for all judges.
15		Scoring the teams individually for the free round in Qualification
16		during free rounds, score set deductions if time not respected
17	Conceptual	Add junior categories?
18	R&R	Change "effective by"-date from March 1st to May 1st to give competitors more time.
