## 14. Insurance

Competitors are responsible for their own personal injury insurance and this is compulsory to all competitors and associated delegates. All competitors must have personal and full medical insurance to cover medical expenses and repatriation.

Event liability insurance, covering Officials, Judges and all other people who paid the registration fee will be arranged by the organizer.

Emergency services will be situated on the Drop Zone for the entire duration of the competition.

A medical facility is situated in close proximity to the DZ.
